History

Kailali Multiple Campus is a leading academic institution in the region, committed to promoting higher education and contributing to the overall development of the students. The campus aims to provide a conducive learning environment, foster critical thinking, and produce competent individuals who can contribute to the society. Forty three years ago, there were not any institutions of higher education in Kailali District. The absence of educational opportunities after SLC, social demand created an urgent need for the establishment of a campus in the district. Prior to the establishment of KMC, most of the students of this region had to go to Kathmandu or India for further studies after SLC. The people of Kailali took initiation for the establishment of a campus. As a result, Kailali Commerce Campus, which was later renamed as Kailali Multiple Campus (KMC) was established in 1980. Financial and other resources required for the establishment of the campus were raised from the efforts and sacrifice of local people. All segments of the society liberally contributed to the campus fund. Initially, KMC was run at Panchodaya School and there were less than 100 students. In 1983, it was sifted to its present premises. At present, KMC has become a part of Far Western University (FWU) since 2021 and there are more than 6,000 students studying in the campus. Since its founding, KMC has prepared thousands of students who are serving several aspects of life in society.

KMC has been a pioneering community based educational institution of Nepal. It is located in a picturesque and peaceful surrounding in the eastern part of Dhangadhi Sub-metropolitan City. Now KMC is a government campus and not-for-profit organization established solely for the purpose of providing higher education. Due to good quality of education, adequate physical infrastructure, affordable fees and convenient location for all districts of the Far Western Region, KMC has been the centre of excellence in higher education.

Infrastructures and Learning Resources

The physical infrastructure of the campus is expanded into 27 bighas of land with different buildings, canteen, Science lab, Computer lab, Geography lab, Health and Sport Centre, hostel (under construction), deep tube-well for clean drinking water and 35KV generator for regular power supply. The college has several plans underway for its overall development.

Conference Centre

KMC has a spacious air-conditioned conference hall and a seminar hall with the capacity of more than 100 people. KMC hosts national and international academic conferences in the conference centre.

F.M. Radio

Radio KMC 104.6 MHz's main focus is on broadcasting student-centred community-based programming. In addition to these features, music and songs are incorporated into the application to make it more engaging. The institution pays close attention to the balance of education, information, and fun in the broadcasting programme.



Research Management Cell (RMC)

Kailali Multiple Campus is effortful to develop the culture of promoting research, consultancy and extension activities to achieve academic excellence. The college has established a research department for conducting research activities. The department calls for research proposal for doing mini-research projects, conducts research oriented workshops and seminars and invites guest lecturers. The college has linkage established for research with Social Inclusion Research Fund (SIRF) and its objective is to generate a vibrant and informed debate on contemporary issues of social exclusion and social inclusion at the regional and local level.

Student Support and Guidance Cell

Kailali Multiple Campus, since its establishment, has been supporting to the students for their all-round development. For this purpose, the college has formed a Student Support and Guidance Cell. As a network of the former students of the college, KMC Alumni has been formed and the association is planning to raise fund and other resources for the development of the college.

Health Centre

KMC provides First Aid services to the students within college hours. Minor injuries and illness are treated within the premises and in case in major injury students are taken immediately to a nearby hospital and informed to their parents. In such cases, students are responsible to bear the medical expenses.

Library

KMC has good collection of various books, journals, magazines, Students Project Reports and so on. They offer access to current, global and relevant information in various formats to serve the information needs of the academic fraternity. The library has incorporated books in the field of Science, Politics, Engineering, Humanities, Management and so on. Besides, KMC provides well-equipped reference and study section and e-library.



Sports

KMC has various outdoor games like Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Badminton and Indoor games like Chess, Table Tennis and various academic games. The students regularly participate in such competitions and bring glory to the campus.



Music Club

For the refreshment and to produce the music artists, Kailali Multiple Campus has established KMC Music Club within its premises and the interested students are practising regularly and getting music class from the music instructor.

WiFi Facilities

KMC provides hi-speed internet access to all the students via free Wi-Fi. The facility can be used for information and research purposes via cell phone or laptops.

Cafeteria

KMC has the provision of canteen and the students can take meal on their self-payment. The canteen serves freshly prepared and well-balanced food to the students and staff. Students are given a choice between vegetarian and non-vegetarian items and can enjoy healthy and nutritious meal.





Auditorium

KMC also provides a large hall for gathering, speech and stage performances. The auditorium has spacious environment, good sound and projection system and well-spaced seating arrangement. Students regularly take part in different activities to enhance their interpersonal skills.



Laboratory

KMC is well-equipped with various modern laboratory equipment. Students can easily relate their theoretical knowledge in practical life too. There are various laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and Computer Science.

Beautiful Garden

As places connected to natural ridge woods, KMC provides recreational and spiritual activities to the community and improve the beauty of the campus. Hundreds of students use the garden spaces for debates and discussions, and lessons are often held there. The campus garden attracts several bird watchers. In addition, residents from the surrounding areas and the city come to the college for morning and evening walks, thus, the collage garden provides a major public service.

Public Information Cell

The college has established a public information cell. The cell publishes KMC bulletin which contains the information related to the academic activities, administrative activities and financial information (such as annual budget and audited financial report) of the college. The cell collects responses from the readers on the published information.

Scholarships and Medals

KMC provides scholarships/freeships to meritorious and deserving students.
